Where will your investments go?

The following chart shows how your future contributions beginning in November 2023 will automatically transfer to the new investment options through the automatic process of “fund mapping.” The options listed in the “Current investment options” column on the left will transfer (“map”) to the options listed in the “Post-transition investment options” column on the right.

Unless otherwise noted below, the mapping process matches current and new options based on fund strategy and objectives, risk profile, holdings, and long-term performance potential.

Important note: Voya is currently crediting interest to the Voya Fixed Account Plus III of 2.50% through November 30, 2024, then 2.25% through November 30, 2026, then 1.5% thereafter. The crediting interest rate thereafter will be that of the prevailing interest rate but not less than 1.00%. Mutual funds under a custodial or trust account agreement are intended as long-term investments designed for retirement purposes. Money distributed from a 403(b) plan, 457(b) plan, or 401(a) plan will be taxed as ordinary income in the year the money is distributed. Account values fluctuate with market conditions, and when surrendered the principal may be worth more or less than the original amount invested. A group fixed annuity is an insurance contract designed for investing for retirement purposes. The guarantee of the fixed account is based on the claims-paying ability of the issuing insurance company. Although it is possible to have guaranteed income for life with a fixed annuity, there is no assurance that this income will keep up with inflation. Early withdrawals, if taken prior to age 59½ will be subject to the IRS 10% premature distribution penalty tax, unless an exception applies. This IRS premature distribution penalty tax does not apply to 457 plans. An annuity does not provide any additional tax deferral benefit; tax deferral is provided by the plan. Annuities may be subject to additional fees and expenses to which other tax-qualified funding vehicles may not be subject. However, an annuity does offer other features and benefits, such as lifetime income payments and death benefits, which may be valuable to you.

For 403(b)(1) fixed or variable annuities, employee deferrals (including earnings) may generally be distributed only upon your: attainment of age 59½, severance from employment, death, disability, or hardship. Note: Hardship withdrawals are limited to employee deferrals made after 12/31/88. Exceptions to the distribution rules: No Internal Revenue Code withdrawal restrictions apply to '88 cash value (employee deferrals (including earnings) as of 12/31/88) and employer contributions (including earnings). However, employer contributions made to an annuity contract issued after December 31, 2008 may not be paid or made available before a distributable event occurs. Such amounts may be distributed to a participant or if applicable, the beneficiary: upon the participant's severance from employment or upon the occurrence of an event, such as after a fixed number of years, the attainment of a stated age, or disability. For 403(b)(7) custodial accounts, employee deferrals and employer contributions (including earnings) may only be distributed upon your: attainment of age 59½, severance from employment, death, disability, or hardship. Note: hardship withdrawals are limited to: employee deferrals and '88 cash value (earnings on employee deferrals and employer contributions (including earnings) as of 12/31/88).

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
